**Criterion A: Knowing and Understanding** 

Students develop factual and conceptual knowledge about individuals and societies

**Criterion D: Thinking Critically** 

Students use critical-thinking skills to develop and apply their understanding of individuals and societies and the process of investigation.



RECOGNISE PERSPECTIVES: Become aware, understand and appreciate the values, opinions and beliefs of their own and others enabling them to be accepting, respectful and kind to others.



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COMMUNICATE IDEAS: Students communicate their ideas effectively and engage in open, appropriate and effective interactions with diverse audiences.

Students develop successful strategies for investigating independently and in collaboration with others.
